Objectives

- to strengthen relationships and understanding among participating countries.

Course Content

1) Course Methodology

An integrated teaching and learning methodology will be adopted. Participants learn through classroom lectures and practical exercises in real situations. The 300-hour course emphasizes basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing general texts and basic grammar. Participants' progress will be tested during the course after 150 hours and also at the end of the course.
