**Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 8:
Prohibition on the Hoarding of Goods**

The seizure of control of Thailand's administration by the Council for Democratic Reform is aimed at bringing about peace and order, prosperity, as well as fairness for people purchasing goods. To this end, the hoarding of goods or raising of prices is prohibited. Whoever violates this prohibition shall be punished with imprisonment not exceeding two years or fined not exceeding 400,000 baht, or both.
