**Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 11:
Appointment of Key Members of the Council for Democratic Reform**

So as to administer the country smoothly as well as to maintain control over any incident that may arise caused by those ill-intentioned towards the nation so that normalcy is restored as quickly as possible, the following persons have been appointed to the Headquarters of the Council for Democratic Reform:

- (1) General Ruengroj Mahasaranond, Supreme Commander of the Royal Thai Armed Forces, as Chief Advisor to the Council for Democratic Reform,
- (2) General Sonthi Boonyaratglin, Commander-in-Chief of the Royal Thai Army, as Leader of the Council for Democratic Reform ,
- (3) Admiral Satirapan Keyanon, Commander-in-Chief of the Royal Thai Navy, as the First Deputy Leader of the Council for Democratic Reform,
- (4) Air Chief Marshal Chalit Pookphasuk, Commander-in-Chief of the Royal Thai Air Force, as the Second Deputy Leader of the Council for Democratic Reform,
- (5) Police General Kovit Wattana, Royal Thai Police Commissioner-General, as the Third Deputy Leader of the Council for Democratic Reform,
- (6) General Winai Phattiyakul, Secretary-General of the National Security Council, as Secretary-General of the Council for Democratic Reform.
