**Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 22:
Cessation of Movements by Local Political Organizations**

Reference is made to the proclamation of Martial Law since 19 September B.E. 2549 (2006) and Announcement No. 7 of the Council for Democratic Reform on 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006), banning all political gatherings of five people or more.

At present, it appears that there have been some movements by members of provincial and district administration as well as other organizations, either with the intention of supporting or opposing the work of the Council. These movements may cause problems and obstacles to the administration of the Kingdom and worsen the sense of disunity within the society.

The Council therefore orders such organization to cease their movements and political gatherings until normalcy is restored to the country, whereupon the Council will make a further announcement.

Any violator will be severely punished.
