Following approval from the Thammasat University Council and with funds provided by the Japan Federation of Economic Organizations (KEIDANREN) and the Federation of Thai Industries (FTI), Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) was established in 1992 to produce qualified engineers and technologists who are competent in advanced technology and proficient in English communication skills.
